- Led a foundational redesign of **Gravatar.com's API and data architecture**, streamlining data structures and successfully migrating approximately **80 million profiles** and 40 million third-party accounts to a new **PHP** based data model supported by **MySQL**. Additionally, transitioned over **200 million** records to SHA-256 hashing to enhance security and future-proof the platform. - Revamped the wordpress.com/forums' design, which supports nearly 1 million posts, while also upgrading to the latest bbPress version to improve security and performance. Developed a seen posts tracking system that manages around 3 million daily entries for the wordpress.com platform.
- Architected wordpress.com/p2 with React mini-apps and dynamic Gutenberg blocks to enable interactive content and integrate GitHub and Slack data. Built as a WordPress plugin, P2 exposes an interface for asynchronous communication, designed to replace email chains and improve collaboration for distributed teams. These enhancements transformed it into a widely adopted tool for structured communication, used by Automattic employees and external customers.
- Designed and implemented a scalable, **multi-tenant** infrastructure for **happy.tools**, a scheduling tool that ensures adequate customer support coverage. Built in **React** with an API powered by **PHP** and **MySQL**, the application was created on an **event sourcing** architecture utilizing **CQRS**, enhancing data retrieval for easier auditing and improved historical accuracy. Developed and launched a **Zendesk integration** for Happy Tools.
- Reengineered Happy Chat, an **internal chat system** for customer support, to improve real-time messaging and scalability. Enhanced the existing backend on **Node.js**, **Socket.io**, and **Redis**, then transitioned to **Elixir** for high availability and fault tolerance. Migrated the frontend to **React**, ensuring seamless support for Automattic's global user base.
